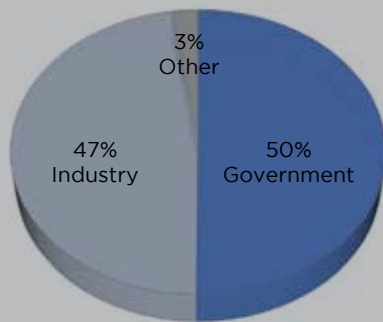

Widely Attended Gathering (WAG) Information

To help determine if this event qualifies as a WAG and beneficial for your agency to attend, we have provided answers to some frequently asked questions.

1. How many attendees are anticipated and from which markets?

More than 2,000 invitations will be distributed to agencies from the DoD, Federal Government, private industry, non-profit organizations, and the media. We anticipate between 700-1000 attendees with roughly 50% from the Department of Defense, federal, state and local government agencies, 47% from private industry and 3% from other groups, such as non-profit organizations and media outlets.
